A DAY IN THE LIFE

Each day of the summer is structured around an opportunity to serve alongside one or more of our collaborators in the region. Typically placed in a local school. Companions may spend their mornings teaching English, facilitating physical education classes, or serving as an elementary school classroom assistant. In the afternoon, Companions will support the after school programs at one of three social service centers administered by a network of Jesuit parishes in Quispicanchi.

A typical day may also include opportunities for cultural immersion and to support specific initiatives of the Quispicanchi Project.

A TYPICAL DAY

Assist with gym classes at Fe y Alegría Primary School
Lunch with community partners at Tinkuywasi retreat house
Afternoon tutoring support for children at the center in Urcos
Dance practice for Día del Cusco at the center in Andahuaylillas

THE DETAILS

APPLICATIONS & COST

The Project's Encuentro program is open to University students entering their sophomore, junior, and senior years or recent graduates.

Applications open in October each year and are submitted online. Applicants will be asked to reflect on their reason for their interest in the Program and ways they can positively contribute to the mission of the Quispicanchi Project.

Candidates will be informed of their acceptance to the program in December, with formation and training beginning in January.

New team members will be expected to participate in all formation and training programs (hosted virtually) as well as complete all required preparation before their departure.

Preference is given to candidates who are functionally proficient in Spanish.

FUNDRAISING

To support their experience in Quispicanchi, all team members participate in a personal fundraising campaign to raise a minimum of \$3600 to cover necessary expenses, including international and domestic travel, housing, insurance, and team activities. A portion of funds will also support Project initiatives.

Companions will have a support team to mentor them through the fundraising process to assist them in generating ideas, setting goals and targets, drafting fundraising emails, and more.
